## A Message from Barry Agnew, Jr., Minister of Students and Education

Students come to me in need of all sorts of advice. One of the more common and yet amusing areas of need centers around romantic relationships. On one such occasion some years ago I had a student come to me wanting some help after a big argument with his girlfriend. Now, it happened to be on a Wednesday night and I was about to leave to go pick up another student so I told the young man to hop in my car and he could ride with me that day. As we drove we talked about biblical approaches to romantic relationships and conflict management. Conversation was going well but the young man stopped dead in his tracks as we pulled up to the residence of the student we were picking up. I'll spare the details but the home was in poor shape to say the least. Truth be told the home situation was so bad that I had been in contact with DSS trying to get the student out for some time at that point. As the young man with me stared at this abysmal living situation he said something that stuck with me. He said, "wow, I guess my problems just don't seem that bad anymore."

You see the young man with me was a good kid that comes from a good family, and had a great home life. The student that we were going to pick up however had none of that. He had a mother in rehab, a father in prison, and lived with another relative that abused him. In my time working with students I can honestly say that easily the single most important factors when it comes to a child's Christian walk are their parents or guardians. So this is where we as a church come in. I ask adults all the time to please invest in our students, but truthfully it's just as important to invest in their parents or guardians. So if I may ask, who can you intentionally invest in today? Maybe there is a parent or a couple that could use some encouraging, or even some discipling? I want to challenge you to go out of your way in the near future to begin engaging with some of our families. Start the conversation and prayerfully consider how you can have an impact in their lives. **The guidance of our faithful and more seasoned saints is both biblical and invaluable. If we truly want to equip the next generation to go and fulfill the Great Commission then we must equip our parents to faithfully disciple their children today.**
